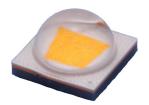

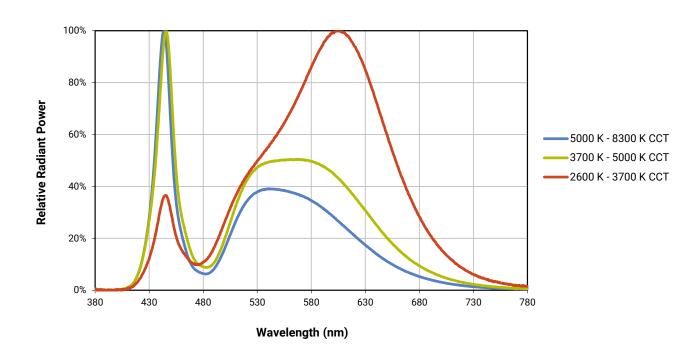

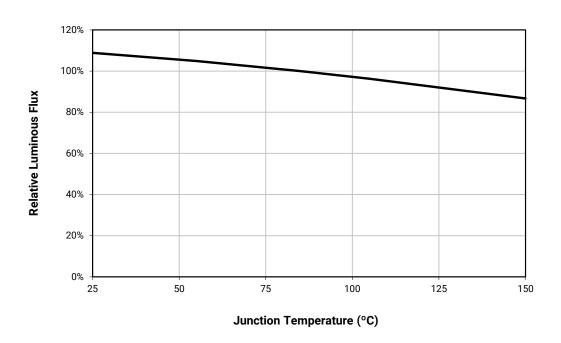

RELATIVE SPECTRAL POWER DISTRIBUTION

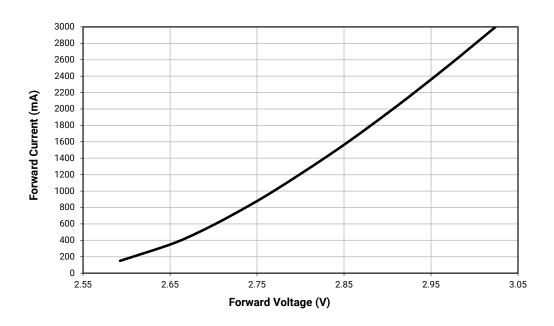


RELATIVE FLUX VS. JUNCTION TEMPERATURE (I_F = 700 MA)

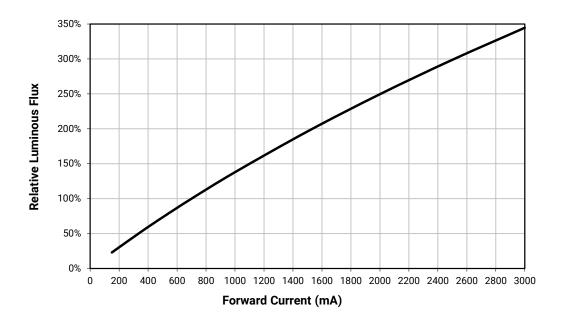




ELECTRICAL CHARACTERISTICS (T_J = 85 °C)

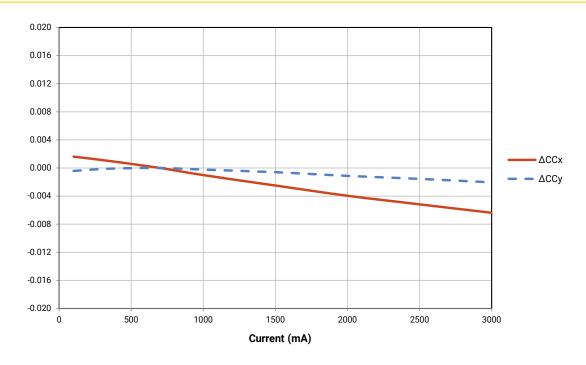


RELATIVE FLUX VS. CURRENT (T_J = 85 °C)

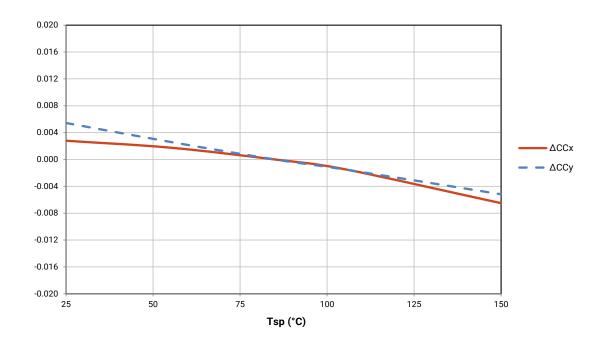




RELATIVE CHROMATICITY VS. CURRENT (WARM WHITE)

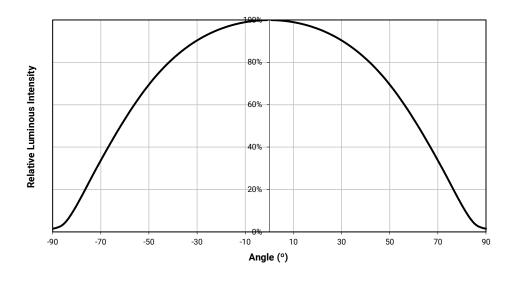


RELATIVE CHROMATICITY VS. TEMPERATURE (WARM WHITE)



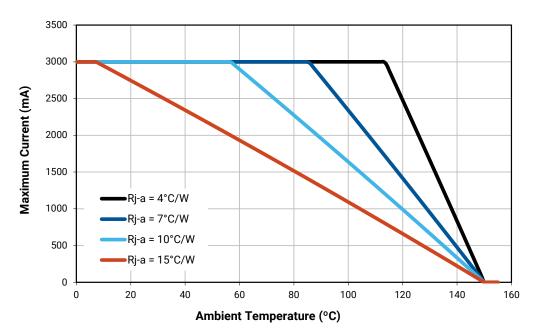


TYPICAL SPATIAL DISTRIBUTION



THERMAL DESIGN

The maximum forward current is determined by the thermal resistance between the LED junction and ambient. It is crucial for the end product to be designed in a manner that minimizes the thermal resistance from the solder point to ambient in order to optimize lamp life and optical characteristics.

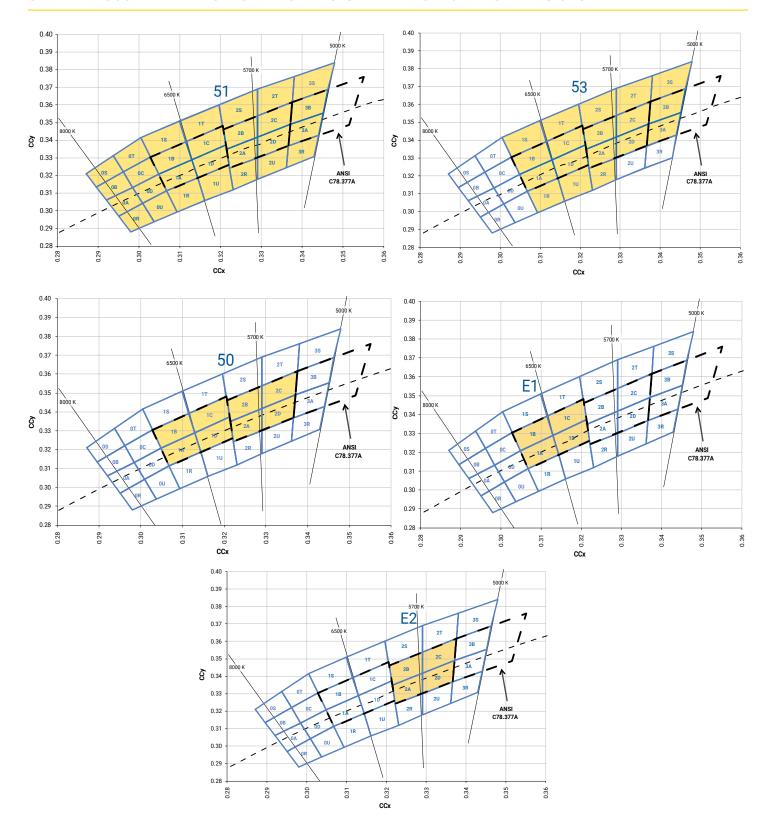

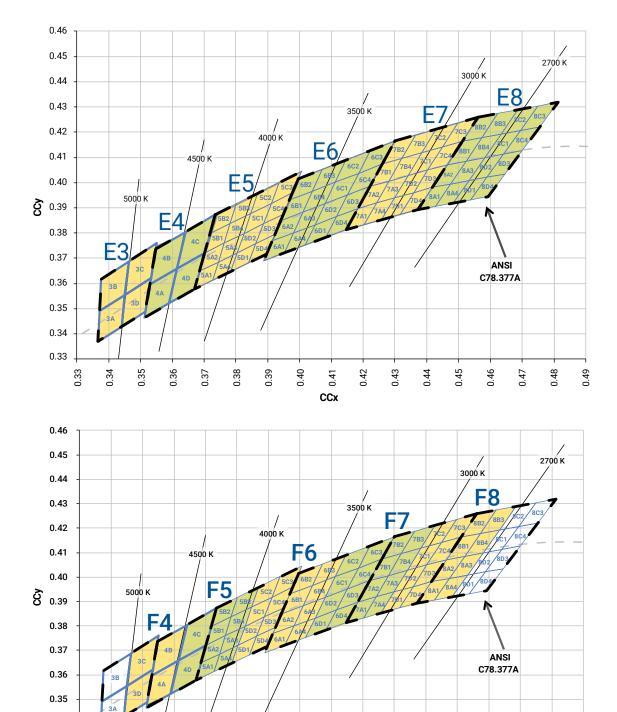


STANDARD COOL WHITE KITS PLOTTED ON ANSI STANDARD CHROMATICITY REGIONS

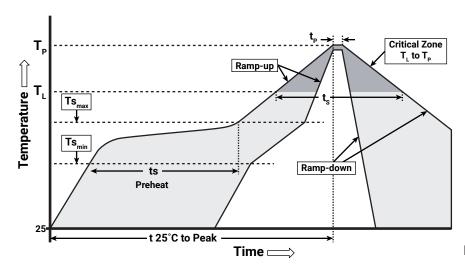




REFLOW SOLDERING CHARACTERISTICS

In testing, Cree LED has found XLamp XM-L2 LEDs to be compatible with JEDEC J-STD-020C, using the parameters listed below. 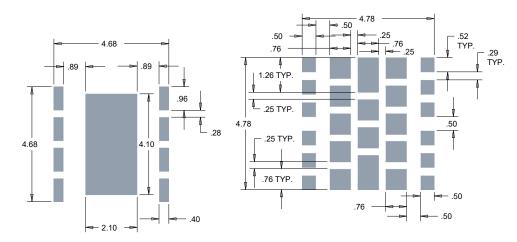


(Solder Mask Pattern)

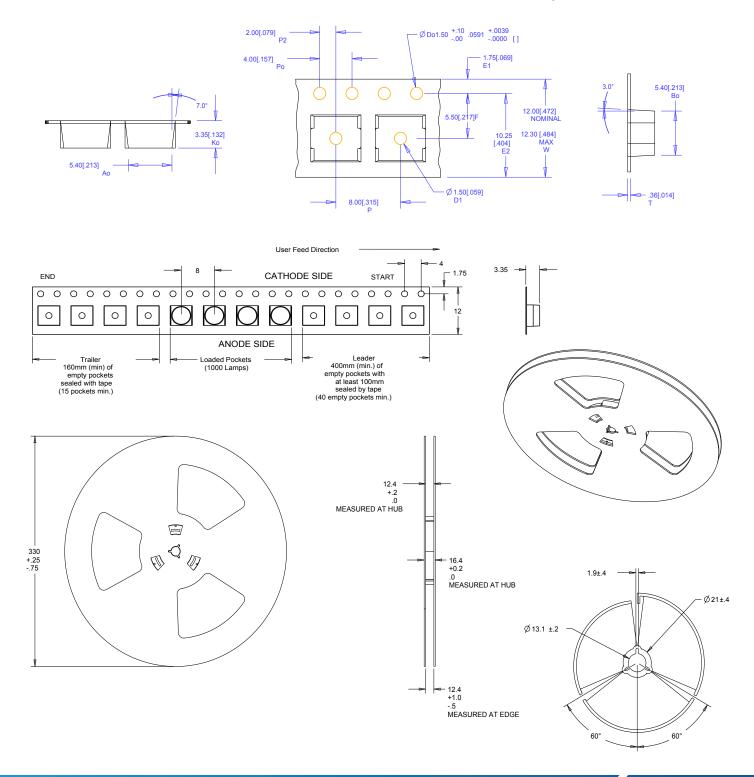
