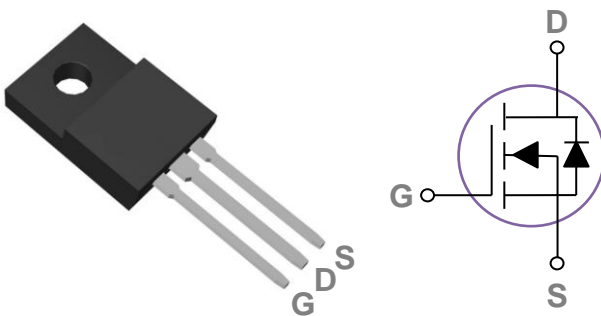

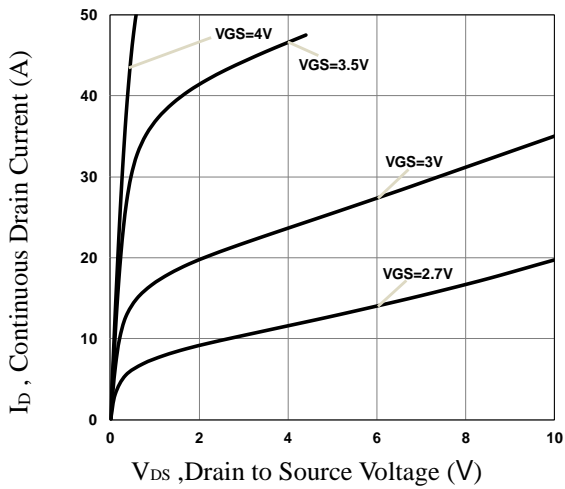


Fig.1 Typical Output Characteristics

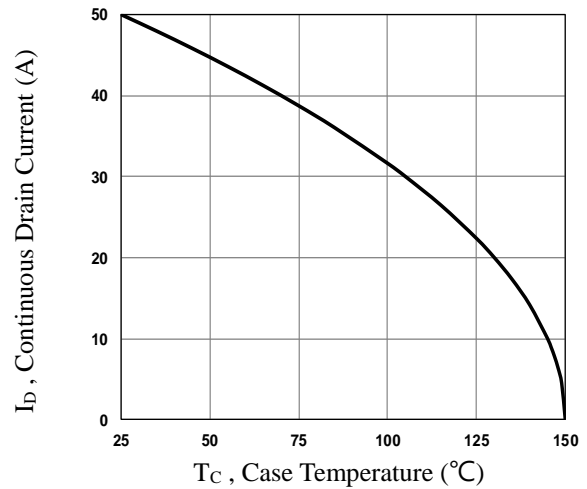


Fig.2 Continuous Drain Current vs. T_c

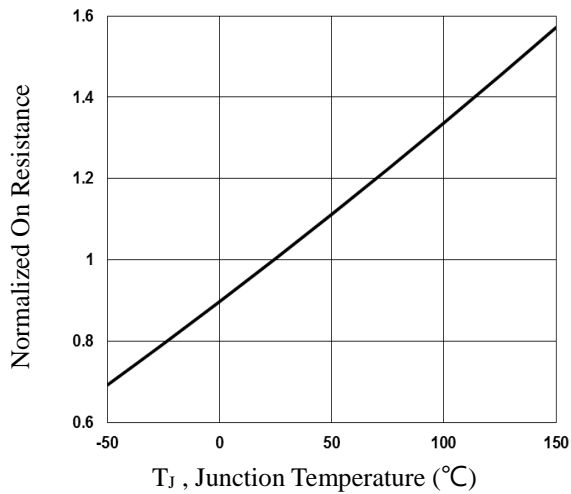


Fig.3 Normalized $R_{DS(on)}$ vs. T_j

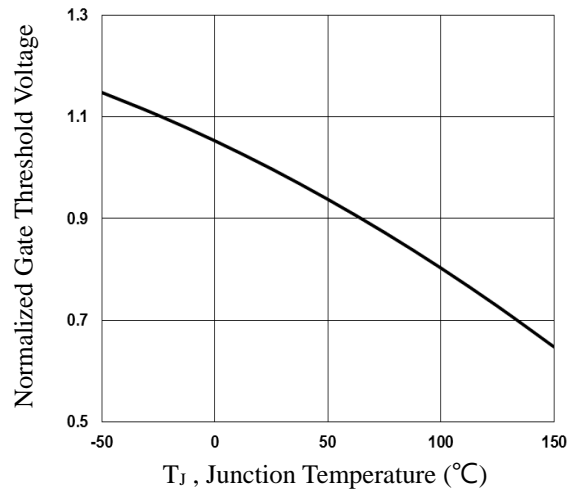


Fig.4 Normalized V_{th} vs. T_j

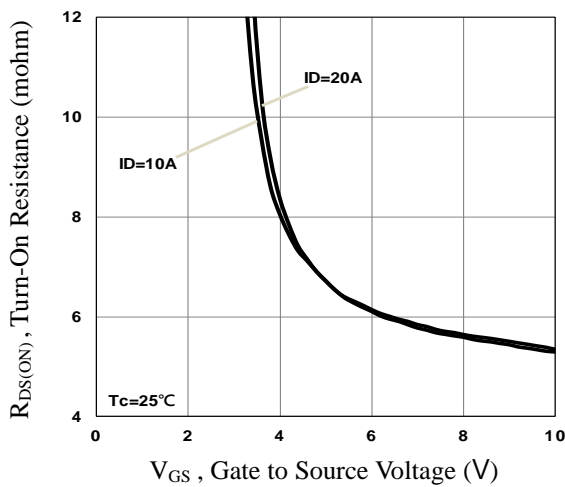


Fig.5 Turn-On Resistance vs. V_{GS}

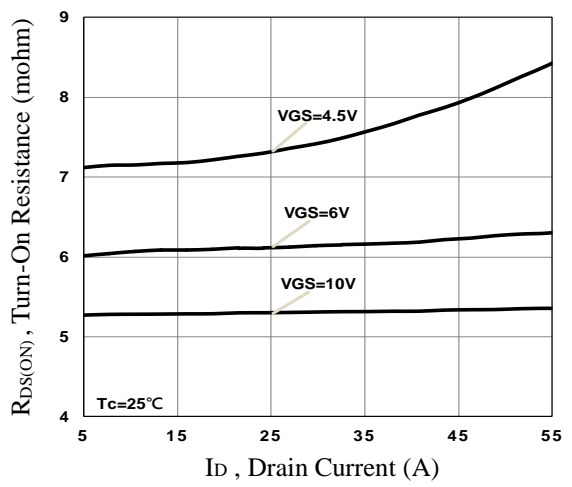


Fig.6 Turn-On Resistance vs. I_D

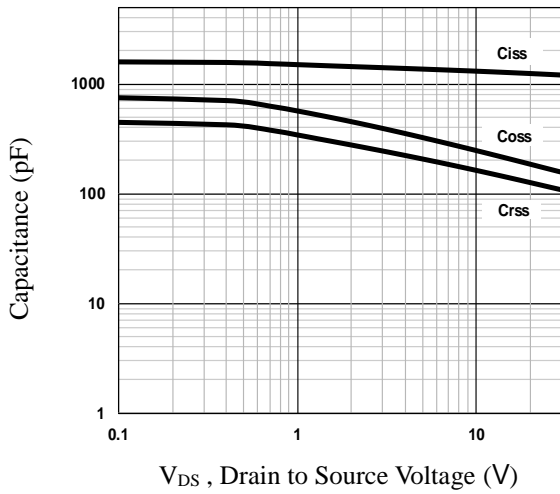


Fig.7 Capacitance Characteristics

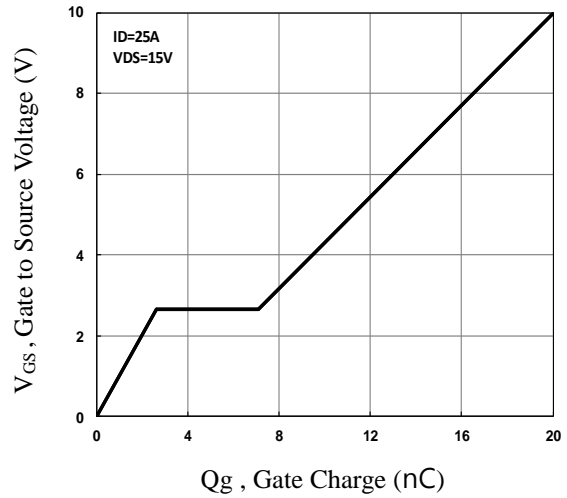


Fig.8 Gate Charge Characteristics

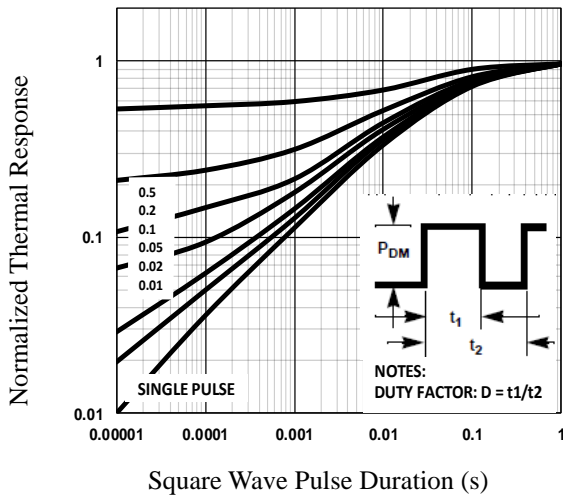


Fig.9 Normalized Transient Impedance

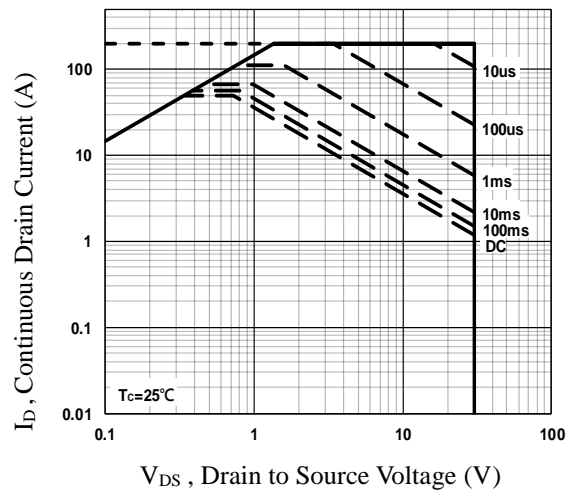


Fig.10 Maximum Safe Operation Area

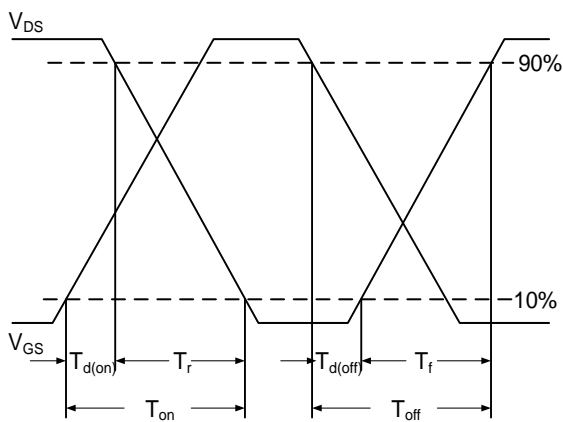


Fig.11 Switching Time Waveform

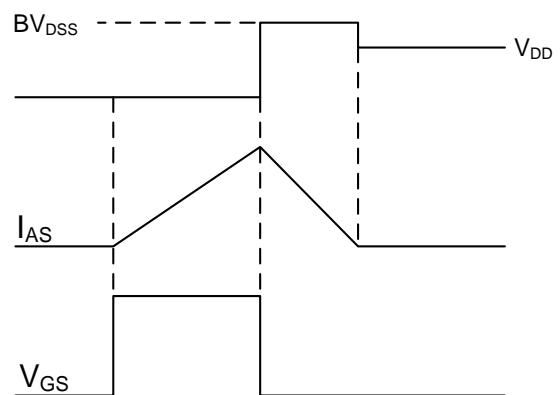
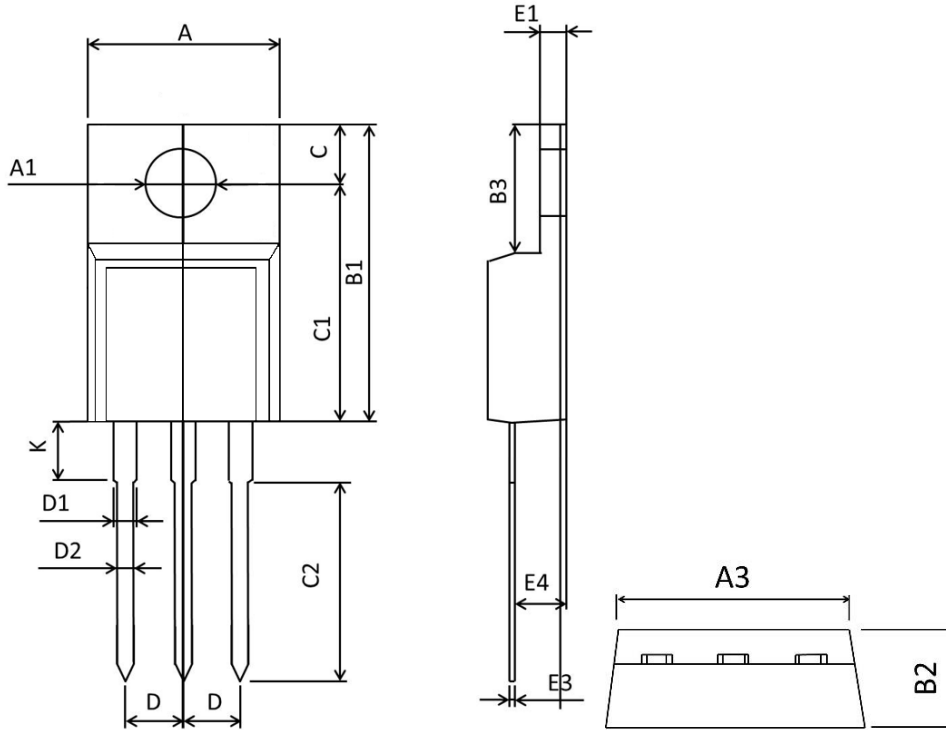


Fig.12 EAS Waveform
